In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 11(1) and 13(1) of the Infrastructure Protection Act 2017, the Minister of Home Affairs makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order is the Infrastructure Protection (Protected Areas) (No. A) Order 2020 and comes into operation on 2020.

Premises declared to be protected area

2. The premises described in the second column of the Schedule are declared to be a protected area for the purposes of the Act, and the person specified in the first column of that Schedule is designated as the authority of the protected area.

Revocation

3. The Protected Area (No. X) Order 200X (G.N. No. S X/200X) is revoked.
